**“Has MRI Realized Its Full Potential?  
Reflections on Past, Present, and Future Utility”**



Prof. Dr. Jessica Bastiaansen, an SNSF Eccellenza fellow and Assistant Professor at the University of Bern and the Department of Radiology (Inselspital), leads a research group dedicated to advancing MRI technology. At the heart of MRI is the use of unique water signatures of biological tissues to obtain critical, non-invasive clinical insights without radiation exposure. In her lecture, she discusses whether MRI has fully lived up to its potential, addressing its complexity and opportunities for richer data and broader applications.
