Prof. Dr. med. Reto Auer, MD, MAS, is a primary care physician and clinical researcher. He is an Associate Professor (Extraordinarius) at the Institute of Primary Health Care (BIHAM), Head of the Substance use Unit, where he leads a variety of research projects, including projects that promote participatory medicine in primary health care for colorectal cancer decision-making, and large randomized controlled trial designed to test the efficacy, safety and toxicology of nicotine vaporizers (Ecigarettes) and the regulation of cannabis for non-medical use.
